LOMA LINDA - More than 400 Inland Empire families, community members and enthusiastic supporters joined in the Childhood Cancer Foundation's 12th annual Brianna Cadman Memorial Kids Walk on Sunday.

The walk is named in honor of a 12-year-old girl who died of cancer in 1999. "The weather was perfect, the families were amazing, and everyone had a good time," said Armida Kersey, the foundation's executive director.

The walk went from the Childhood Cancer Foundation of Southern California on Mountain View Avenue to Loma Linda University Children's Hospital on Anderson Street.
